Janelle visited our Alexandria Center for a pregnancy test after she started experiencing pregnancy symptoms. She had recently been in a vehicle accident and experienced several negative tests as a result. However, her test with an SLM nurse proved positive. Janelle was shocked. "I'm afraid...but...I don't know." She was struggling with depression and said she wasn't sure how she could handle another baby after already having two children. She had also experienced several miscarriages and had lost her mother several months before (who she was very close to). She appeared overwhelmed. Her compassionate Client Advocate (CA) listened to her difficult story and offered comfort though the gospel. Janelle said that she had been feeling distant from God and wanted to rededicate her life to Him. Her CA prayed with her and assured her that God would provide for and guide her, and that the SLM pregnancy center would be there to support her.

After an ultrasound a few weeks later, Janelle decided to carry! Christ's love and the encouragement she received moved her to choose life. We praise God for the work He is doing in Janelle's life and the comfort he is blessing her with. God is faithful, and we are grateful that she has chosen life for her baby!


We are so close to our goal! Although October is over, we are still working to

Dear SLM Partners,

In this season of change, SLM is excited to welcome Janet Custer, our new CEO! As the Lord would have it, God was stirring both Janet Custer and I through prayer at similar times about God's calling in our mutual ministries. By no accident, Janet's resume came across my desk after I had shared with the board that I felt the Lord was calling me to step down and retire as CEO. Janet and I met via Zoom several times and I was excited to share her resume with our SLM Board. I believe God has brought Janet to SLM for "such a time as this" and I have faith that God is leading Janet to take SLM to the next level of medical care and mission focus.



A Florida native, Janet Custer comes to SLM with vast experience in the work of Pregnancy Centers across the country. Janet's deep love of God's Word, Biblical principles and care for women was developed through Bible Study Fellowship where she attended twelve years and served as the Teaching Leader for five years. In 2013, God called her out of BSF to a local pregnancy center in Naples, Florida. Within eight years, Janet grew the one pregnancy center into three medical clinics and one Education

Center providing care and support that included pregnancy testing, sonograms, the Abortion Pill Reversal procedure, STI testing and treatment. Women stayed in the program for 15 months receiving care and support from advocates and medical professionals including their own OB/GYN. Her vision, strength and integrity changed the landscape of SW Florida by integrating patients from her clinics into local churches where their faith and family would continue to grow.

Before coming to SLM, Janet has served as Sr. Director at The Obria Group, a national network of women's health care clinics in seven states. Under her leadership, The Obria Group saw a 25% increase in the reach to abortion determined women leading to 812 babies being saved within six months.

Yet amid this great work around the country, God put a burden in her heart to serve in her community. Fueled by her passion and driven by the urgency of this work, she envisions a transformed community where every baby is wanted. She is grateful to her husband of 36 years, David and their 4 children, three sons-in-law and two grandchildren.

Her decision to come to SLM was guided by Ephesians 5:15-16 "Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time because the days are evil."

Please extend a warm welcome to Janet!! She will be reaching out to our partners in the coming months and is eager to get to know you.
